Blessed are You, **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** our Elohim, King of the universe, Who purifies us with Your commandments and commands us to hear the voice of the Shofar. In the Name of **וְיָשׁוּעַ** the Messiah. Amein.

**Shofar Blowing**

**Yachad/Congregation all point the Torah** (which represents YAHWSHUA the Living Torah)

**We zot ha Torah/And this is the Torah-** Debarim/Deut. 4:44<sup>1</sup> & Bemidbar/Num. 9:23<sup>2</sup>

We zot ha Torah asher sam Mosheh leaf'nai benai Yisrael,<sup>1</sup> al pei **אֱלֹהֵינוּ**, be yad Mosheh.<sup>2</sup>

And this is the Torah that Mosheh placed before the children of Yisrael,<sup>1</sup> from the mouth of **אֱלֹהֵינוּ**, through the hand of Mosheh.<sup>2</sup>

**Eytz Chayim/Tree of Life-** Mishle/Prov. 3:18<sup>3</sup>, 17<sup>4</sup> & Eykah/Lamen. 5:21<sup>5</sup>
